- It may be destroyed in unexpected circumstances such as floods, fires and earthquakes.
- It could also get lost, damaged or simply misplaced.

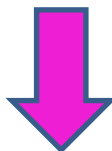

STORAGE AND RETRIEVAL PROCESS



Following registration of your Will at The National Will Archive,  will receive your 'personal reference number'. We will record this in your customer file and you will receive correspondence of this 'personal reference number'.



For Retrieval you or your executor contacts  quoting your 'personal reference number'. We will respond to you within 24 hours (7 days per week) to arrange retrieval from The National Will Archive. (There is a small charge for this service – payment of which will not delay the retrieval process).



We will post your Will to your current address Recorded Delivery or Collection from Office is available.



The cost of retrieval is based on postal charges prevailing at the time and administrative process involved. Current charges are listed within our Terms of Business
